
Figure 1, and this explanation, were prepared by

Call me Michael Cooper, the newspapers are. I always wanted to commit the perfect crime. Now I've got \$200,000 tax free to prove it. That's alot of bread even after a three-way split.

I've been hatching this plot a long time-in fact ever since I got out of the Army. Returned to Portland, my home town. Couldn't find a job and I tried hard, real hard. But no one appreciated my ability. Now the whole world is appreciating my ability. There's no denying \$200,000.

Boarded this Boeing 727 November 24th at Portland. It was just what I wanted.

Soon as I got on I handed this stewardess a note ordering her to stick close and if anything went wrong my briefcase would go off taking everyone with it. I had dynamite wired up in my case and I showed it to the broad to prove I was serious.

Told her to tell the pilot to notify the airport in Seattle to have money ready when we arrived. And two sets of parachutes should be thrown in for good neasure.

I wasn't about to take chances. This was kind of a milk-run so chances were againt an air-marshal being on board. This would be the first major heist in the Northwest ever. That Green Baret training in viet Nam came in handy for something.

I stayed in the back close to this stewardess. Don't think anybody really knew what was coming off, except the crew. Andthey were very efficient and cooled #.

They knew enough not to spook me. I had long before decided that my life and that of a few others were well worth the risk for all that money. Besides before I had not to show for my life, now I do. I grant you money isn't all, just 99% and besides someday I can make another mint off my nemoirs.

Circling the area for two end a half hours, we finally settled down. They didn't fool me none. The old Northwest Airlines Inc. was probably recording the serial numbers, all 10,000 of them, because I wanted the money all in 2015. Maybe even a big outit like that had trouble putting together \$200,000 at that the of missing the once on the ground I allowed the 36 passengers and two stewardssess to discontinued.

FBI - SSATTLE

Ordered to the plane to refuel and prepare for immediate take-off on schedule to Reno. There were official-looking gents all over the place, alot of them FBI men. I imagine. Finally, this courier type guy boarded the plane mcgave the small white pouch to the stewardess that I allowed to remain to be the interpreter. Oh, and last but not least the chutes. The dough seemed in order; it only weighed about 20 lbs.

We took off about 7:30. Right on schedule, my schedule. This is where the timing came in. Made the stewardess enter the captain's cockpit. Can you imagine, that famely dame, when I first handed her the note and declared myself, actually thought I wanted a piece of her instead of the action. She got so she treated me with a little more respect, or should I say, fear. That's the way a man should treat a woman, under him. You give them much quarter and they'll stomp on you.

Well, back to that night. I got what little crew was left, four to be exact, up front. Oh, the instructions given to the crew upon taking off were to leave the flaps down at 15°, unlatch the passenger door, to level off at 7,000 ' and to not exceed 95 knots. They were also told the lattitude-longitude course to take. I had everything a thought out, meedless to say. I've been around planes before and I've made drops before, plenty of them and not just in Viet Name. Was a smoke fighter once. And I knew the drop-out area like the palm of my hand. For several weeks I practiced precision dropping at the Crehards Chute Landing Area in SW Washington. And for all you'll ever know I might have had kin or somebody in the area, might I not?

Well, back to the story because this is where the action got fierce. Figured I had 30 to 45 minutes before make the drop. Lots to do. Taking my hunting knife out I slashed up a secondary chute and strapped the money around my waist. Put my long flashlight and K rations about my person. Ch, and I had a 38 revolver which I never had to flash. Ind then the big job. To check out the main chute. That was awkward but I had been practicing that too trying to cut down my time. I had to rush that a little but that's the chames you take. Defused the dynamite, opened the door and tossed it out. Repacked the main chute, strapped it on my back, put the reserve chute on my chest which I learned afterwards had been sewn shut. That's a laugh. They must

take me for a complet idiot. Why the hell do you think I ordered two sets of chutes. I didn't take many chances, not many at all.

It wasn't a bad night for a drop--overcast but I would bail clear of that.

Checking my time, I cleared the altitude and speed with the captain over the comline. Everything was about right even though I missed the airport beam at Kalama
because of poor visibility. I had to clear Lake Morwin. Clearing the clouds, I

floated down. Heard later there were three military trail planes but they couldn't
